

## **NOTE FROM THE EDITOR**



As I write this, it's the beginning of May and I'm starting to see a break in the weather with what is now finally looking like spring! Come June I'll be happy to get digging in the garden and enjoy more of the outdoors.

Many of you in Crossroads love to bring that beauty to your yards and

show off the care and attention you give. I know it takes a lot of patience and hard work and I just want to let you know that it is very much appreciated by those who walk by your home.

June is also the month we give thanks to our fathers. Father's Day is June 18th, although it has been a rough road to have this date established as a national holiday in the United States.

The Catholics have long since the Middle Ages celebrated fatherhood on St. Joseph's Day, March 19th. Although it wasn't inaugurated in the US until the early 20th Century to compliment Mother's Day.

The first celebration of Father's Day in the US was on July 5, 1908 to pay tribute to 250 fathers who died in a mining disaster in Fairmont, West Virginia, leaving around a thousand children fatherless. Unfortunately, this was never celebrated outside of this town and no proclamation was made.

On June 19, 1910, a Father's Day celebration was held in Spokane, Washington to honour William Jackson Smart, who was civil war veteran and a single parent raising six children. His daughter, Sonora Smart Dodd, proposed the idea to her paster to have it held on her father's birthday, June 5. It ended up being deferred to the third Sunday in June. Again, the idea died and no proclamation was made.

In the 1930s, Dodd started raising awareness at a national level. Although it wasn't until 1957 that Senator Margaret Chase Smith wrote a Father's Day proposal accusing Congress of ignoring fathers for 40 years while honouring mothers.

In 1966 Lyndon B. Johnson issued the first presidential proclamation honouring fathers, designating the third Sunday in June. Six years later, the day was made a permanent national holiday when signed into law in 1972. Unfortunately, in Canada it's not a public holiday.

I was surprise to learn how recent Father's Day was established and the struggle to get it recognized. Although, any day of the year is a good day to honour your father.

Happy Father's Day and I wish you many wonderful moments with your children.

## **Mayland Heights Elementary**

In the 1950's, the land surrounding the school was all farmland. The whole section of land east of 19th Street between 16th Ave and 8th Ave was owned and farmed by Mr. Albert Henry Mayland. He owned the Union Packing Plant and had an extensive hold in the oil industry in Turner Valley. His family still owns property in the area near Joey Tomato's and the Real Canadian Wholesale Club. The school first broke ground in June of 1967 and opened its doors on Mar. 31/1969. Its unique design has won some awards and some criticism, but that has not kept it from becoming a great landmark to our community.

Does anybody remember Mr. Formanek? The first principal of this school, along with 27 teachers were hired. The first teachers were as follows: Mrs. M. Brucker, Miss U. Bruhn, Mrs. Dawson, Miss P. Dun, Mrs. A. Engel, C.W. Evans, S.C. Formanek, T.H. Gates, Miss A. Hawryliw, Mrs. A. Hendricks, Mrs. C. Hesketh, A. R. Hunter, Mrs. P. Jack-

son, Miss M.A. Kazakoff, Miss P. Lovick, Mrs. M. Martin, H. Massie, P. F. Moeller, Mrs. H. O'Connor, Miss N. Papove, Mrs. L. Quiring, Mrs. R. Rawlusyk, Mrs. G. Samson, Miss M. Stakenas, Mrs. M.A. Sware, Mrs. M. Veldehoen, H. Williams, Miss C. Wise.

## Responsible Pet Ownership in Parks

As we all enjoy being outside and spending time with our family, friends and pets; we want to ensure we are creating as safe place for all our neighbours. Knowing and adhering to the regulations in the Responsible Pet Ownership Bylaw 23M2006 helps to ensure that dogs are not being a nuisance in the community and dogs and citizens are safe.

City of Calgary would like to remind dog owners of the

- When off of their owner's property, dogs must be on a leash unless in a designated off-leash area.
- · When in designated off-leash areas, dog owners must ensure their dog is under control, is within their sight and responds to commands.
- Parking lots adjacent to off-leash areas are on leash.
- · Owners are responsible for picking up all waste produced by their dog.
- Dogs are not allowed in school grounds, playgrounds, sport fields, golf courses, cemeteries, wading and swimming areas, and other areas prohibited by signs.
- Dogs must be walked on the right-hand side of the pathway on a leash that is no more than two metres in length and must not interfere with other pathway
- · Owners cannot cycle, in-line skate or skateboard on a pathway with a leashed dog.
- · Dogs must not enter or swim in any body of water within a park except a river that runs through, or is adjacent to, a City park.
- Dogs must have and wear a City of Calgary licence when the dog is three-months-old

When we respect the bylaw, we contribute to a safer and healthier community.


## **Green Carts are coming this summer**

Starting this June, green carts will be rolled out to all households for food and yard waste collection. Here are some details on the rollout.

#### **Green cart collection start dates**

Green carts will be rolled out by quadrant. Once all residents in a quadrant have their carts, collection will begin as follows:

Quadrant	Cart delivery	Weekly green cart collection starts:
Southwest	June 5 - July 15	Week of July 17
Northwest	July 3 - August 12	Week of August 14
Northeast	August 7 - September 2	Week of September 4
Southeast	August 28 - September 30	Week of October 2



# Weekly green cart collection starts

## Three things to do when your cart arrives:

#### 1. Bring your cart up to your home.

Carts will be delivered to the front of your home. Bring your cart up to your home and store it in a safe place (e.g. garage, against the side of your house or back fence).

#### 2. Look inside the green cart.

Everything you need to get started is inside the cart. This includes:

- Kitchen pail and sample compostable bags.
- Sample paper yard waste bags for extra yard waste that doesn't fit inside the cart.
- Instruction guide and collection schedule.

#### 3. Consult your collection schedule.

The collection schedule inside your cart explains when green cart collection starts in your quadrant along with your new collection days and schedule. You can also find out your collection days and sign up for free automated reminders at calgary.ca/collection.

## Subsidies are available for City services



## I'm on a condominium board, and we have decided to hire a professional management company. Do they need to be licensed?

This is one of the most common questions we get. The answer depends on what they are going to do on behalf of the Board of Directors, and how they will handle the condominium corporation's money.

Condominium managers are responsible for collecting condominium fees, arranging property maintenance (according to instructions from the condominium's Board of Directors), assisting the Board of Directors with enforcing the Bylaws, and other duties set out in the Bylaws.

The Real Estate Act does not specifically refer to condominium management, but it does say that individuals need a licence if they collect contributions, or money, for the control, management, or administration of real estate.

So, if a condominium manager is collecting condominium fees, or other such fees such as special assessments, do they need a licence?

If a condominium manager collects the money payable to the condominium corporation, deposits it directly into the condominium corporation's account, and they are not carrying out any other activities that fall under the definition of trading in real estate, they do not require a licence.

If a condominium manager deposits the money payable to the condominium corporation into the management company's account for any period of time, no matter how short, they do require a licence. As a member of a condominium Board of Directors, you and your Board will have to think about how you want your management company to collect and hold fees. If the company will hold them in its own account, they require a licence.

Licensing requirements provide some protection for consumers when a third party, for example a management company, holds consumer funds. All licensees are required to have Errors and Omissions insurance, and there is a consumer compensation fund that compensates consumers who suffer a financial loss as a result of fraud, breach of trust, or a failure to disburse or account for money held in trust. The compensation fund is only available to consumers who are working with licensed professionals on trades in real estate or deals in mortgages.

In December 2014, the Government of Alberta passed legislation that will require licensing for all condominium managers; however, the government has not announced the date on which those legislative changes will come into effect. In the meantime, the licensing requirements detailed in this article continue.
