

### Spring is here!

The lake is now open for fishing! Boats will not be allowed on the lake until the water temperature is consistently above 10°C. See our website for information on the lake status or call the office if you have any questions. A reminder that flagpoles are located around the lake and at the Front Entrance. RED: full closure (stay off and far away from the water).

YELLOW: partial closure (contact the lake office or check the website for updates).

GREEN: the lake is open for all activities

### Catch and Release ONLY!

At this time, only catch and release fishing will be permitted at Arbour Lake, until further notice. THERE WILL BE NO KEEPING OF ANY FISH OF ANY SIZE OR KIND! This is a result of Alberta Environment and Parks shutting down all fish stocking within the bow river drainage area, of which Arbour Lake is included. Due to whirling disease found in the Bow River and commercial fish culture operations, the lake will not be stocked indefinitely, and as such, no fish may be kept indefinitely. Any fish that cannot be returned to the water, must be surrendered to a staff member.

Have your kids grown out of their new clothes before actually wearing them? Do you have clothes in your closet taking up space that you don't really wear? Arbour Lake Residents Association has a clothing donation bin in front of the lake office, close to the fire lane. Drop off your gently used clothing to help clear up the clutter in your closet. 

### When can I book hall rentals?





### Peace Lily (Spathiphyllum wallisii)

Peace Lilies are native to the South American rain forests where they grow on the forest floor. The soil is rich in peat moss and humus, providing the plant with decayed organic material, bark, and aeration for the roots.

The rain forests are warm and humid, and being on the forest floor under the cover of the tall trees provides shade from the hot sun; this is the perfect growing environment for Spathiphyllum.

So, what is the perfect growing environment for a Peace Lily in your home?

Simulate the natural environment of the forest floor where the sunlight is indirect and dappled; a north or western exposure is the best. Keep your lily about 6 - 8 feet away from the window; this allows for consistent light levels; maintain temperatures 65 - 80 degrees Fahrenheit and avoid cold drafts. Misting your lily often provides humidity and keeps the leaves clean and glossy allowing for better photosynthesis. Rich potting soil with humus or peat moss, such as an orchid type of soil will allow for drainage and the necessary aeration for the roots. Avoid potting mixtures that contain soil as they will be too heavy and may contain fungus or pests, and may also contain fertilizer, which the Peace Lily needs very little of.

Even when we provide all the necessary requirements for our lily, we may still see some symptoms of problems. The most common symptom is brown leaf tips. This could indicate that your Peace Lily has too much light or too much fertilizer.

A droopy Peace Lily is wilted, usually from a lack of water, but will recover quite quickly. Be sure to water your lily until the excess water runs out the bottom of the pot. A Peace Lily that droops often (more than once a week) may mean that it needs to be re-potted.

One significant improvement that has been implemented is the new transit service to Nolan Hill, which is the new Route 82. The new Route 82 connects Nolan Hill to the Sage Hill Hub (Walmart), the Brentwood LRT Station and to the Beacon Hill shopping centre. This route also provides bus stops near the communities of Sage Hill, Sherwood and Kincora. Route 82 runs every 30 minutes during peak hours. Calgary Transit has also changed the name of Route 429 Sherwood to Route 129 Dalhousie – Sage Hill to better represent the connections available on the route.


