## ENMAX NO.47 SUBSTATION

### ACCESS ROAD REVISION PROJECT OVERVIEW

ENMAX Power Corporation (ENMAX) owns and operates No.47 Substation, located in the Stoney Trail Transportation Utility Corridor east of Evansford Road NW. ENMAX currently accesses this substation via an access road off 14 Street NW.

Alberta Transportation (AT) has informed ENMAX that we can no longer use 14 Street NW to access the No. 47 Substation, because it now conflicts with their design standards. AT design standards do not permit access roads in close proximity to interchanges along freeways. ENMAX must therefore access the substation from another location. Several options were considered, and

a new access road at the north end of Evansford Road NW, was determined to be the most viable option (see above).

### PROJECT DETAILS

The project requires the construction of a 200 metre access road and installation of a new City of Calgary Standard Emergency Vehicle gate. ENMAX anticipates accessing the substation once per month for general maintenance and annually for a full inspection with a one tonne truck or utility truck (examples shown to the right).

Subject to Alberta Utilities Commission approval, construction is expected to begin in Q4 2016 with a proposed in-service date of Q1 2017. Prior to construction ENMAX will notify affected stakeholders.

ENMAX is committed to being a responsible corporate neighbour in the community. This commitment includes providing timely and meaningful engagement with stakeholders about this project.

We have provided opportunities for area residents, occupants and landowners to be informed about this proposal and to engage with ENMAX in dialogue from the planning phase through to construction.

## Winter Driving Fuel-Efficiency Tips

With its cold winds, long nights, and merciless snows, winter can be an ordeal for both you and your car. But beyond all the extra windshield washer fluid and maintenance your ride will need, your fuel budget will likely see the biggest bump — gas use can spike by over 25 percent, adding more to an already-too-large chunk of your budget.

This is because the cold winter air puts more aerodynamic drag on your vehicle and your engine has to work harder to plow through all that snow and slush. But you can fight back with a few surprisingly simple tricks:

1. Chill out and go easy. Aggressive driving uses much more gas than you'd expect. Speeding up and slowing down suddenly makes your engine work harder than it should, so take it smooth and steady behind the wheel to see some savings.
2. Plan ahead. Beyond driving more gently in general, you can cut down on gas use with some simple planning. By keeping a careful eye on traffic ahead and keeping your speed down, you can save yourself the painful start-stopping that drives up your gas use, and still arrive on time. Working to curb those bad habits can save you time at the pump and aggravation on the road. And whenever possible, plan your route ahead of time using radio traffic alerts or a smartphone app that

helps you avoid any gas-guzzling jams.

3. Don't idle to start up. Are you using a remote starter or starting your engine then running back inside to let your vehicle warm up? Don't fall for the driveway-idle trap — not only does it suck up gas and increase emissions, idling for more than 30 seconds doesn't give any extra benefit. All you need to do to warm up your car is to drive it gently for a few minutes. You'll be warmed up and on your way in no time.
4. Keep an eye on your tires. Tire pressure changes with air temperature, so check your tires at least once a month to make sure they're inflated correctly. Driving on tires that are under-inflated by as little as 8 psi can cut their life by more than 10,000 km and drive up your gas use to boot.
5. Use a block heater. Block heaters warm up your car's engine before you start and can cut down on gas use dramatically by eliminating the need for you to warm up the engine at all. Use a timer on the block heater for added convenience; just set it to turn on about 2 hours before you need to drive, and you're off to the races with a pre-warmed engine, gas in your tank, and money in your pocket.

It has been a busy fall season in the House and I am proud to be bringing your voice in the legislature. Earlier this fall I was proud to join many of my colleagues at the State of the Province Address in Calgary to hear Premier Notely speak to our government's challenges and commitments. The Premier addressed many new initiatives that the government will be setting in motion in the New Year.

The Carbon Levy Rebate will start to roll out to families in January of 2017. These rebates are automatically available to you, if you have submitted your 2015 income tax return. For small business owners and investors, the Alberta Investor Tax Credit and the Capital Investment Tax Credit are two new tax credits which will be available starting in January of 2017 to support small- and medium-sized businesses. #### **Joe's Tip: Joe's Holiday Eggnog**

Ingredients:  
4 eggs  
120 ml sugar  
500 ml of milk  
½ tsp of vanilla  
1 tsp. Rum flavouring  
May add optional pinch of nutmeg and cinnamon

Directions:  
Put the milk, vanilla, and optional cinnamon and nutmeg in a saucepan, and heat on low setting until mixture is brought to a boil.

In a bowl, combine egg yolks and sugar and thoroughly blend together.

Pour the eggs mixture into the saucepan with the milk mixture. Cook over medium heat, stir in rum flavouring and stir mixture until it reaches desired thickness (3-5 minutes).

Refrigerate until cool.

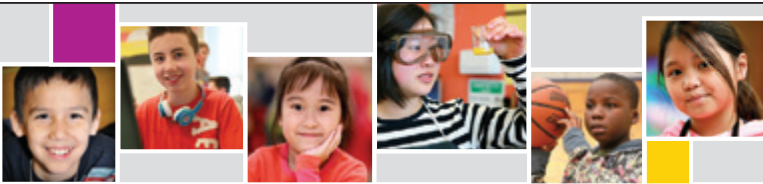
