## Do You Get Community Emails?

We currently communicate with you through our web-site, www.kincora.org. Once you create an account on our site, we have the ability for us to send an email to those that have opted-in to receive emails from us. You **must opt in** to receive any emails about the commu-nity. You do not have to purchase a community asso-ciation membership to get emails. Registering for an account is free!

Here's how to do that:

1. Visit www.kincora.org
2. Login to your account using the login & password that was provided to you via email if we created your account for you. (It is likely login=last name, password=membership number). Or this is a login & password you created yourself after you registered on the website.
3. Go to Members >>> Profile >>> Email Options
4. Check off "I want to receive special emails sent to all members from the webmaster."

Emails are only sent when we communicate something that we believe would be of interest to you – typically this is an average of two per month. You can also control if/when you are notified of other website activities, like when news or calendar items have been added.

Storm Drains

There are approximately 48,000 storm drains in Calgary. Last year, 311 received more than 1,600 calls related to storm drains and drainage issues including water ponding, pooling or ice build up and debris on storm drains. The City historically receives the majority of its storm drain –or ‘catch basin’- calls in March.


Storm drains are the main way water gets into the underground pipe system. The metal grates that can be seen at the edge of the road are only a portion of the structure which is primarily under ground. Under the grates is a barrel that collects the water. The barrel is attached to a pipe that allows the water to be whisked away and eventually deposited in the river.


If you see a storm drain clogged by debris or snow, and it is safe to do so, you may remove the debris to allow for water to run freely into the drain. If a storm drain is encased in ice, please contact 311 so it can be thawed with specialized equipment – do not attempt to remove the ice yourself. Also, do not attempt to clean a catch basin if it’s submerged in water. You cannot be sure if the grate is intact, presenting a safety risk. If the drain is covered in water, please contact 311.



## Smoking and Home Fire Safety

The place where we feel safest — at home — is where most smoking-materials structure fires, deaths, and injuries occur. Smoking materials are the leading cause of fire deaths. Every year we have over 500 fires started due to smoking materials, this is preventable and can be reduced!

### Some tips to remember:

- If you smoke, smoke outside. Most deaths result from fires that started in living rooms, family rooms and bedrooms
- Keep cigarettes, lighters, matches and other smoking materials high out of the reach of children. We have found the kids to be very observant regarding “hidden” lighters.

### Put It Out, Right Out!

- Use a deep, sturdy ashtray. Place it away from anything that can burn.
- DO NOT discard cigarettes in vegetation such as mulch, potted plants, landscaping,
- peat moss, dried grasses, leaves or other things that could ignite easily.
- Before you throw away butts and ashes, make sure they are out. Dousing in water or sand is the best way to do that.

Your Calgary Fire department has been called to many fires burning on the outside of homes from ignited peat moss in planters while occupants were sleeping inside.

**Did you know that** in addition to your Fire Department being highly trained to battle fires, that we have specialty teams that are further trained in airport rescue, structural collapse, confined space, dive rescue, high angle and hazardous material response?

## EMS: Bicycle Helmet

### Safety

Head injuries are a leading cause of serious injury and death to children riding bicycles\*. Most injuries occur when a cyclist suffers a fall, strikes a stationary object, or collides with another cyclist/pedestrian. Remember – it’s the law in Alberta that cyclists under the age of 18 must wear a helmet (and highly recommended for all ages). Helmets should be CSA approved and worn during recreational activities such as skateboarding, in-line skating, or cycling.

### Getting informed

- Wearing a helmet while cycling can prevent a serious injury, or even save a life;
- Brain injuries can cause permanent disability or death;
- Reduce your risk by always wearing your helmet;
- Replace any helmet that has been involved in a crash, even if it appears undamaged.

### Getting started

- Allow children to assist when buying their helmet. Cyclists who choose their own helmet are more likely to wear them;
- Start the habit early. Young children learning to ride tricycles need to wear helmets;
- Parents must lead by example – always wear a helmet when cycling.

### Getting the right fit

- Take the time to properly fit and adjust your helmet to ensure maximum protection in case of a crash;
- When worn properly, helmets should fit level, not tilted up, or down over the forehead;
- Helmets should feel snug, but not too tight. To test the fit, the helmet should not fall off when you shake your head from side-to-side while the straps are unfastened;
- Adjust the chin straps to form a “Y” below and slightly forward from the ears;
- Only one finger should be able to fit under the chin strap when it is fastened;
- Do not forget to use the sizing pads included with the helmet. They will help improve the overall fit, comfort and safety.

### MP Pat Kelly Introduces Motion to Study CRA Duty of Care to Taxpayers

Greetings residents of Calgary Rocky Ridge! Let me start by thanking you for choosing me as your representative in Parliament. I look forward to working with the Community Associations, individuals, and other stakeholders to voice your concerns in Ottawa and advocate for sound policy on your behalf. To that end, I would like to tell you about my Private Member's Motion to increase protection for Canadian taxpayers.

After each general election, a new session of Parliament is convened and all MPs are given a chance to put forth a bill or motion. My name came up as number six in the draw, meaning that I will be in the first batch of private members' business.

My motion instructs the House of Commons Finance Committee to study and report on ways to create a duty of care between the Canada Revenue Agency and Canadian taxpayers, such as by enhancing the Taxpayer Bill of Rights and making it legally enforceable. The motion also proposes empowering the CRA Ombudsman's Office to direct CRA to comply with Tax Court orders and official decisions. These measures should provide clear expectations for CRA, and should protect taxpayers from frivolous, vexatious, malicious, and grossly negligent behaviour by it.

This spring, Transportation Network Companies (TNCs) like Uber will be able to legally operate in The City of Calgary. Like most Calgarians, I believe in free enterprise, which is why I supported the creation of a new bylaw to provide more choice and competition amongst TNCs. The new bylaw will allow TNCs to operate in a fair and competitive market. They address citizen, driver and passenger safety and ensure greater competition and customer service. The bylaw proposes common sense requirements for TNCs' including:

- An annual operating licence from The City of Calgary;
- Valid Class 4 driver's licence;
- Annual Calgary Police Service (CPS) background check;
- Proof of valid commercial insurance as required by the Government of Alberta;
- Proof of eligibility to work in Canada;
- Proof of provincially-approved 134-point mechanical inspection, conducted annually or every 50,000 km whatever comes first.

While it is important that we have more choice and competition amongst TNCs, it is also important that the new bylaw provides adequate safety and security for both drivers and passengers of TNCs. I believe that this new bylaw will achieve this balance and provide all Calgarians with more choice, and allow TNC's to operate in a fair and competitive market.

Over 100 people attended the open house on the Sarcee Trail Interchange at Stoney Trail to provide their feedback on the proposed improvements. These improvements will make the interchange safer, more efficient for all users and help reduce travel times for the movement of goods and for commuters traveling southbound on Sarcee Trail to eastbound Stoney Trail.
