

#### **New Permits**

The Planning Committee met early in November to review the latest development proposals.

- DP2017-4572 Multi-Residential (1 Building, 4 units) at 4607 17 Av NW
- DP2017-4494 New Single Detached Dwelling 4719 23rd AV NW
- DP2017-4913 New Assisted Living (240 units) 353 Smith St. NW

#### **Cambridge Manor Assisted Living Building**

The Planning Committee had the opportunity to review the Development Permit drawings for the new Assisted Living building complex. This development will be located in the new University District on the east side of Shaganappi Trail and just north of the recently completed intersection. At four storeys tall, it will support 240 units.

#### **Medical Marihuana Counselling Centre**

The Planning Committee reviewed the Change of Use application for a new Medical Marihuana counselling centre. We had reviewed the same application at a previous meeting. The initial application did not meet the distance requirements for that Use; namely, it must be 300m away from other businesses with the same use and 150m away from any school.

### UNIVERSITY DISTRICT UPDATE

As a valued neighbour, we wanted to let you know about some upcoming changes to the University District (U/D) traffic network. *This update will be of particular interest to those who travel by car, foot or bicycle in and around the U/D site.* 

#### CONNECTIVITY Road Network:

On November 14 (weather dependent) we are looking to restore pre-existing conditions and traffic patterns which include the following:

- Opening of **University Ave & McLaurin Intersection** which will coincide with the opening of all of McLaurin.
- Children's Way (adjacent to Rotary Flames House) will be open to McLaurin (right turn only).
- The entrance to Lot 57 will be restored to its original location. See the map below. Please follow the signs and proceed carefully to park.

#### Multi Modal (Pedestrians and Cyclists):

- The pathway detour installed this spring will remain.
- A temporary pathway will be established along University Ave to provide an additional pedestrian connection and a more direct route to the main campus from the western portion of the site.
- Please use care when walking through the site as it is still an active construction area.
- The existing pedestrian corridor along the east side of 39<sup>th</sup> street will remain.



#### SAFETY

- Additional digital signs will be placed next week to provide travelers with advance warning of upcoming changes.
- Standard construction signage will be in place to instruct motorists at key intersections, and other areas requiring extra caution.

Bag these types of stretchy plastic bags together for recycling:

- Plastic grocery bags
- Sandwich/Ziploc bags
- Dry cleaning bags
- Bread bags
- Vegetable and produce bags
- Saran wrap/cling wrap
- Bubble wrap
