

Recently I was told that the City does not collect cycle use data on Nose Hill and there were no 311 calls about it. Now there is a colour-coded Global Heatmap of human activities, such as running or cycling on the regional pathway system. You can use the toggle labels to check locations, for Nose Hill Park or your community. Through social media athletes network in real time.

Local Action for Biodiversity means each local government has a long-term local strategy, action plan, and will implement on-the-ground initiatives. The edits to The City's biodiversity webpage have now been made. The page better reflects the strategic plan, as well as providing details on the BiodiverCity Advisory Committee. She is just in the process of collecting photographs now and if people are interested they should email them to her. She hopes to have the online photo gallery put together and posted within the next couple of weeks. "We are featuring photos that were taken in Calgary. The idea is to show all of the wildlife that can be found within city limits. We will credit the photographers, identify the animal/bird in the photo, and let people know approximately where in the city it was photographed."


In 2014, City Parks and Roads received a one-time grant from the Council Innovation Fund of \$300,000 for an automated, interactive Parks and Roads Map. With the number of 311 service requests, it has been challenging to have accurate information. Soon the system on www.calgary.ca will improve access to up-to-date data for Parks and Roads services, such as mowing and snow ploughing.

Calgary has one of the highest allocations of greenspace of any city in North America. There are 693 natural areas which make up over 50% of the park space in Calgary. Natural areas give priority to the protection of vegetation and wildlife over human use when the two come into conflict.



Ward 4 Pedestrian Safety Town Hall

In February I hosted a Ward 4 Pedestrian Safety Town Hall meeting. This meeting was held to collaborate with residents and City of Calgary staff in order to see what can be done to improve overall Ward 4 pedestrian safety.

The meeting was well attended, and I want to thank City representatives who spoke about the Safer Mobility Plan, Pedestrian Strategy, the new Green Line, and the Calgary Police Service Traffic Unit. Each spoke on what impact their projects will have on Ward 4 residents and pedestrian safety.

The evening was a great success and a great opportunity to disseminate and collect information. The feedback we received was greatly appreciated and will be summarized and shared with all relevant City of Calgary business units. From this it is hoped that common safety themes can be identified and we can then work toward permanent solutions. This type of collaborative work leads to meaningful changes on our streets.

Ward 4 is the most transit orientated area in the City and, unfortunately, with that comes higher rates of pedestrian incidents. In order to address this important fact we must work together to mitigate the risks as much as possible. My goal over the next year will be to take the information that was collected at the Pedestrian Safety meeting and use it to make Ward 4 a safer place to live, work and commute.

I also want to take this opportunity to let Ward 4 residents know that with the proposed LRT Green Line, Centre Street will undergo significant modifications. This means important alterations in how pedestrian and traffic moves around Ward 4. While this is occurring I will work hard to keep you informed and ensure the City incorporates your input into the changes.

Greetings, residents of Calgary-Northern Hills,

It's April, and spring is coming to Calgary along with the hope of a fantastic summer for everyone.

Even before Budget 2016 was tabled in the Legislature, the Royalty Review, the Job Creation Incentive Program and the Petrochemicals Diversification Program were all released to serve as a foundation for economic stability.

In January, I attended the public release of the eagerly awaited report from the royalty review panel.

The Royalty Review

The panel was led by ATB Financial CEO Dave Mowat. Over the course of the review the panel listened to industry, labour, academics, environmental groups, community leaders and businesses and more than 20,000 Albertans in person and online. The panel determined that Alberta's royalties are comparable to similar jurisdictions, but the industry's costs are substantially higher. As a result the panel recommended a modernized framework that set a drilling cost allowance for wells according to an industry-wide average, rewarding producers who reduce drilling costs below the industry average through innovation.

The royalty review Advisory Panel's recommendations were adopted by the government. The new royalty system is expected to attract investment, create jobs, reward innovation and increase revenue over time.

Job Creation Incentive Program

Jobs and the economy are a priority for this government. Government has announced the new Job Creation Incentive Program as part of Budget 2015 – the most extensive program of its kinds in Canada, creating as many as 27,000 new jobs per year. Grants will be provided to employers for net new employment created after January 01, 2016. Grants will be work \$5,000 for a new job and employers will be eligible for up to \$500,000 in total support – the equivalent of 100 new full-time positions.

Petrochemicals Diversification Program

We are encouraging economic diversification by investing in Alberta's strengths. One of those strengths is the petrochemicals sector, which uses methane and propane to create everything from plastics to detergent. Alberta is already a leader in this field. We are encouraging further growth through a royalty credit that is expected to attract investment in new manufacturing plants and good jobs here in Alberta.
