


Basement

Web World One Does Your Small Business Need a Mobile Website? (Part 2 of 4)

As mentioned in the January article, mobile matters and you may want to open this discussion with your web person which should start with reporting but also defining some language in which they may be speaking. I will define these mobile website definitions for fixed reference and relativity. Take any

debate with these from a developer standpoint with a grain of salt; if they don't agree with the terminology just get them to define them on their terms so you can start your discussion somewhere.

These are defined from your point of view as a website user, not using developer language, and do not include behind the scenes website building methods.

1. Mobile Device – I will define this as any reasonable and current electronic device that can view a webpage in graphical form (images, colors, typography) through an internet browser and would include smartphones and tablets. It could or could not include the ability to change screen size from vertical to horizontal. I will include notebooks/laptops here only due to the wealth of different screen sizes, and their true nature as mobile.

2. Mobile Version – I will define this as a website that looks vastly different on a mobile device from the desktop version in operation, although could be similar in brand colors and identity. Big areas to touch with access to further information through scrolling, swiping, or easy to identify touches.

3. Mobile Adaptive / Responsive – I will define this as a website that adjusts 'on the fly' to altering screen sizes shown through the changing in design specifics. Menu operation, font size, and content layout adjust to screen size and orientation. It has the same look as the desktop

version but will 'jump' to adjusted (not different) formatting upon down and upsizing. It will work well both vertical and horizontal.

4. Mobile Friendly– I will define this as either number 2 or 3 above.

5. Everything else would probably just be put in a category that the site 'works' mobile. It is probably the same as the desktop site, a bit inconvenient to use through zooming in/out, up/down, left/right, and lots of menus. It might have a few minor formatting issues with image galleries but mostly still looks aligned and correct and "works" including video and animation.

Next month I will discuss reading into your reports to help make the mobile decision.



Heart attack risk factors include:


Obesity

- Sedentary lifestyle
- Smoking
- High cholesterol
- Age / Gender
- Family history

Speak with your doctor about how to treat your modifiable risk factors and learn to be heart safe.

What to do when seconds count

- Call 9-1-1 immediately. Early treatment can greatly reduce heart damage and make the difference of life and death.
- Treatment starts the moment EMS arrives. Paramedics can provide oxygen, start an intravenous and perform an electrocardiogram (ECG).
- Paramedics can also administer important medications in the early minutes of a heart attack to lessen heart damage.
- During transport, EMS will also share information with the hospital so definitive treatment can begin immediately on arrival.
- Take a CPR/AED (automated external defibrillator) course. Training is widely available from many reputable organizations. It's easy, inexpensive, and only takes a few hours.

National Flag Day of Canada – February 15th

The official ceremony inaugurating Canada's new flag was held on Parliament Hill in Ottawa on February 15, 1965, with Governor General Georges Vanier, Prime Minister Lester B. Pearson, members of the Cabinet and thousands of Canadians in attendance.

The Canadian Red Ensign, bearing the Union Jack and the shield of the royal arms of Canada was lowered, and at the stroke of noon, the new red and white maple leaf flag was raised, as the crowd sang our national anthem, "O Canada" followed by our royal anthem, "God Save the Queen".

The red and white used in the flag were proclaimed the official colours of Canada by King George V in 1921; the maple leaf has historically been used as a Canadian symbol since the 1800s.
