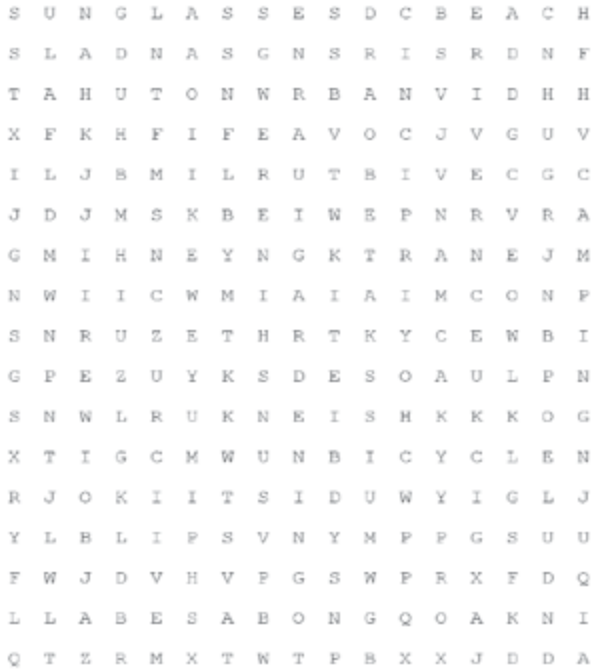

**Accidental Poisoning**

Alberta Health Services EMS would like to remind parents about precautions they can take to prevent childhood poisonings. Ingesting medications, prescription, or over-the-counter products, is the leading cause of accidental poisoning in children. Even small amounts of adult medications can be seriously harmful, or even fatal to your child if swallowed. Other causes of poisoning are household products, such as dishwasher tablets and personal care items (mouthwash, nail polish etc).

**Medication storage**

- Store all medications in a locked container and place in an area inaccessible to children.
- Keep medications in their original child-resistant packaging.
- Do not mix multiple medications inside one bottle.
- Install child locks on all cabinets, or drawers where medications are stored.

**Safety tips**

- Ensure visitors to your home keep their personal belongings out of children's reach. They may contain unsafe items.
- Take extra precautions with medicines that appeal to children such as chewable vitamins, or flavored cough and cold syrups.
- Properly dispose of any medications, or toxic household products no longer in use.

**Prevention**

- Store household products, car supplies, and cosmetics in locked cupboards, or drawers.
- Apply child safety latches to drawers and cabinets, if they are within a child's reach.
- Know and label all plants in and around your home and garden.
- Antifreeze, windshield washer fluid, and pesticides are extremely poisonous. Even small amounts of these can cause serious illness when ingested.
- Poisoning information can be obtained by calling the Poison and Drug Information Service (PADIS) at: 1-800-332-1414.

**In case of a poisoning emergency, call 9-1-1.**

Provide the name of the product ingested or, if it is safe to do so, a sample of the substance for EMS to inspect on their arrival.

We visited the Okanagan recently, and had a wonderful time touring wineries, gardens, and of course enjoying good times and good food with our friends Duane and Lisa. Lisa is always on the lookout for interesting recipes and was happy to share some of her newest “finds” with me. I think you’ll enjoy the flavours in these fall-off-the bone ribs, and the smooth texture of the maple dessert. Mmm, so good!

## BARBECUE RIBS WITH RUM

- 4 lbs pork baby back ribs
- 1 cup light brown sugar
- ¼ cup ketchup
- ¼ cup low sodium soy sauce
- ¼ cup Worcestershire sauce
- ¼ cup amber rum
- ½ cup chili sauce
- 1 clove garlic, crushed
- 1 teaspoon dry mustard
- Coarsely ground black pepper to taste

Cut the ribs into serving size portions and wrap securely, as one layer, in heavy aluminum foil. Place the foil-wrapped ribs on a sheet pan and bake at 350 degrees F for 1 ½ hours. Remove ribs from the foil and transfer to a shallow dish.

In a separate bowl, whisk together all the other ingredients for the barbecue sauce. Pour 2/3 of the sauce over the ribs, cover, and marinate for approximately one hour at room temperature. Set aside the remaining 1/3 of the sauce to baste the ribs with when grilling.

Preheat barbecue to medium heat and spray grates with non-stick cooking oil. Place ribs on the grill and cook for approximately 30 minutes, basting with the remaining barbecue sauce.

## MAPLE CREAM

- 1 envelope unflavoured gelatin
- ¼ cup cold water
- ½ cup milk
- 2/3 cup maple syrup
- 1/8 tsp. salt
- 2 cups whipping cream
- Additional maple syrup

In a small bowl, sprinkle gelatin into cold water and let stand for one minute.

In a small saucepan, bring milk to a gentle boil and stir in the gelatin mixture until dissolved. Remove from heat and stir in maple syrup and salt. Cover and refrigerate for approximately 45 minutes, until partially set.

In a large bowl, beat the whipped cream until stiff peaks form; fold into the gelatin mixture.

Spoon into 8 individual serving dishes or martini glasses; cover, and refrigerate for at least 4 hours before serving.

Drizzle with a little additional maple syrup before serving.

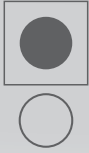

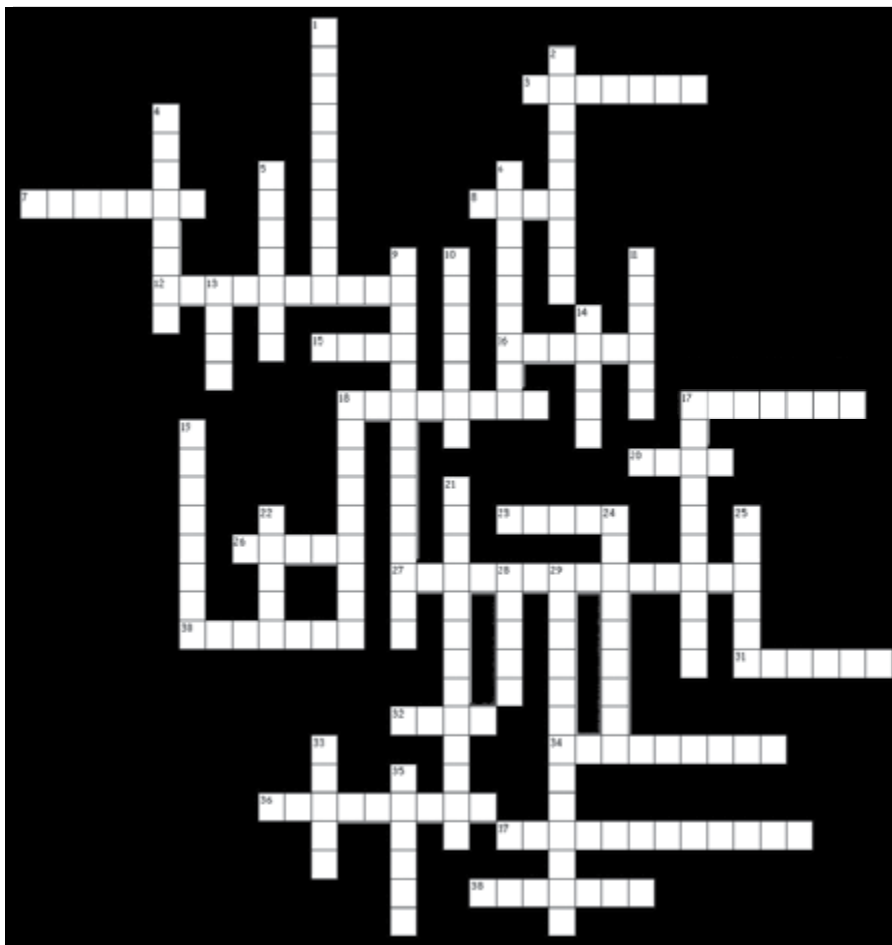

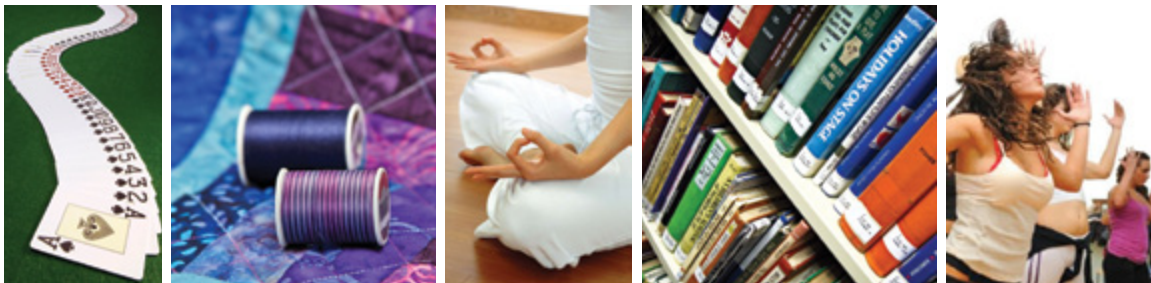

Your Calgary Public Library card provides greater value than ever with the arrival of the **hoopla** digital media platform. **hoopla** enables access from your mobile devices or web browser to streaming content, including 124,000 music albums, 8,000 videos, and 10,400 audiobooks. And with convenient 24/7 access online, **hoopla** can bring great content to you when you can't get to the library.

The way to get started: 1) Get a Calgary Public Library card 2) Go to the Calgary Public Library website and click "Getting Started on hoopla" at <http://calgarypubliclibrary.com/books-more/featured-digital-content/hoopla>. Or ask the friendly staff at your local Calgary Public Library to help you.

Each Calgary Public Library cardholder can borrow 12 titles a month. Loan periods vary: movies/tv are available for 3 days, music albums are available for 7 days, audiobooks are available for 21 days. No need for holds and no waiting since access is simultaneous: everyone can listen to the new Coldplay "Ghost Stories" album at the same time. Titles expire automatically; no fines and no need to return items. Use the Favorites list to plan for your future **hoopla** use.

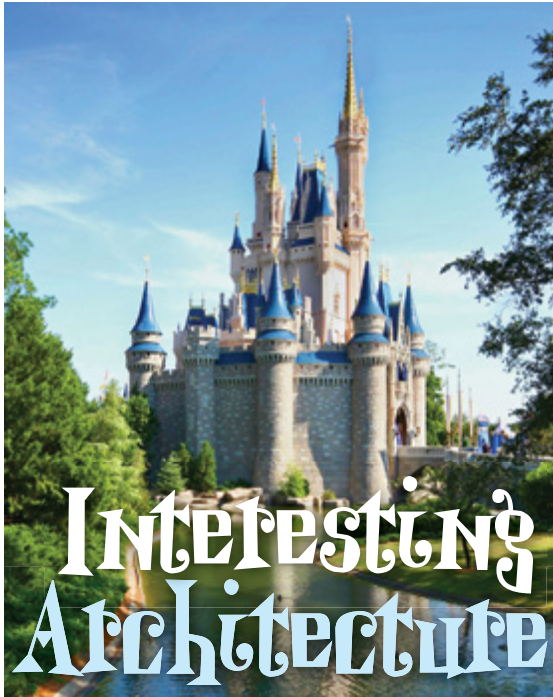

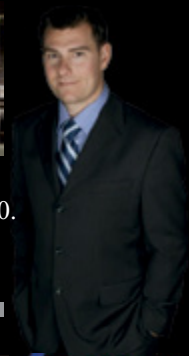
