# Furnace Scam Warning for East Calgary

The City of Calgary has joined with the Calgary Police Service to once again warn residents after receiving several reports of aggressive and potentially fraudulent furnace salespeople visiting homes in eastern Calgary.

The salespeople go door-to-door telling residents that they are building inspectors and that they must be allowed inside to inspect the home's furnace or else the residents could face fines. Once inside, the salespeople claim to find problems with the furnace and/or hot water tank and aggressively try to sell the homeowner new ones.

Police investigators are currently working with The City of Calgary Licence Division to investigate these incidents. Calgarians who have similar experiences are asked to report it to our non-emergency line at 403-266-1234.

The Service and The City would like to share the following tips with Calgarians when faced with situations like these:

- Always ask to see identification to confirm that people are who they say. Legitimate door-to-door salespeople are required to have visible identification in Calgary.
- City of Calgary building inspectors generally only visit homes by appointment, or in emergencies. They always have City of Calgary photo identification and drive marked City of Calgary vehicles.
- Before allowing a contractor into your home, ensure you are dealing with an approved contracting company that is properly licensed and insured. The City of Calgary's new contractor tips and tools page on calgary. ca/myhome provides valuable advice and an online business licence database for valid contractors.
- If you encounter a door-to-door salesperson or business without a business licence, report it to 311.
- If you are told your furnace does not meet safety codes and must be replaced, you can often check this information with The City of Calgary's Technical Assistance Centre at calgary.ca/tac to make sure it is true.

October is a time to reflect with gratitude on the people and good in our life. This October I have much to be thankful for, family, friends, and a love of serving the people and province of Alberta.

Legislative Session will be starting at the end of October and I expect some lively debate! When we are not in session, the business of the Legislature of Alberta still goes on. Committees have met throughout the summer and will continue to do so through the fall. There are currently 10 committees for the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, which comprise of standing committees, special committees, and legislative policy committees. I hold a position on both the Standing Committee on Alberta's Economic Future and Standing Committee on Public Accounts. The mandate of the Standing Committee on Alberta's Economic Future relates to the areas of Agriculture and Forestry, Advanced Education, Infrastructure, Economic Development and Trade, Culture and Tourism, and Labour. The Standing Committee for Public Account's mandate is to review the reports of the Auditor General of Alberta and the public accounts of the province. It is an honour to serve on both of these committees and represent not just the constituents of Calgary-Fish Creek but the interests of Albertans at this critical time of financial instability.

Currently two of the Standing Committees are inviting public input to review two pieces of legislation: Child and Youth Advocate Act and the Lobbyists Act. The Child and Youth Advocates responsibility is to represent the rights and interests of youth and children who are involved in the youth justice system or who are receiving interventional services. As the role of the Lobbyist has evolved, a review of the act is an opportunity to ensure the legislation is more current with new mediums of communication and connecting with politicians. I would encourage you all to visit the assembly website www.assembly.ab.ca to access both of these surveys.

It was a pleasure for the office to be represented at Andrew Sibbald School's new playground opening. It is a beautiful new playground and will be well used by the school and community for generations to come. I com-

mend their efforts to enhance the children's school experience as well as benefitting the community. The parent group at Andrew Sibbald was able to access Alberta grants available to not-for profit community groups through Alberta Culture. Since 1998 Community Initiatives Program (CIP) and Community Facility Enhancement Program (CFEP) has distributed more than 1.1 Billion to not-for profit community groups across Alberta. The funding for CIP/CFEP grants are unique as the money does not come from general revenue/taxes but is sourced through lottery revenues.

Our next MLA Café sessions will be Friday October 28<sup>th</sup> 10-11am and Saturday November 5<sup>th</sup> 9-11am. I will continue to vary the times and days to allow for all to attend. I would encourage you to come out to meet me and my staff to share your thoughts on the legislative process and current government policy. Your engagement with me and my office ensures I can effectively represent you in Edmonton.



# The Importance of Reporting **Crime**

Did you know that a substantial amount of crime isn't reported to police?

There are many reasons that people choose not to report a criminal offence. They may feel that it is too minor in nature or that nothing can or will be done. They may feel that it's not worth the time or effort or that police have more important things to do.

The Calgary Police Service pays close attention to reported crime statistics within communities and across areas of the city. In fact, statistical analysis can be a driving force behind how our Service chooses where and how to deploy resources.

Analysis of reported crime allows police to identify 'hot spots' of activity and also helps to measure and pinpoint emerging crime trends. A lack of accurate data makes identification of these locations difficult and unreliable.

So-called 'minor' crimes such as car-prowling (theft from vehicles), vandalism and other property related crime can be an indicator of a larger problem in a community. An increase in these types of crimes can indicate that an offender has moved into an area, that additional police resources are needed, or that something else has changed within the community. Becoming aware

of each of these factors is important for police to move forward in addressing community concerns.

#### How to report a non-emergency crime

The emergence of technology has made crime reporting much easier and faster, and allows police to obtain an up-to-date glimpse of what is going on in the community.

- By phone 403-266-1234 (police non-emergency line)
- Walk-in to your local District office

If there is an ongoing situation within your community, you also have the option of contacting your area Community Resource Officer (CRO) through your local District office to make them aware.

#### How else can you help?

- · Encourage your family, friends and neighbours to report crime or suspicious activity within your community.
- · Be aware of your surroundings. If something or someone seems out of place, there is likely a good reason for this. Report any suspicious behaviour to the police.
- · Lock it up! Don't provide offenders with any opportunity – secure your vehicle, garage and home (including closing windows when you are away and at night).

**Greetings Ward 14!** 

Thank you to those who attended my Ward 14 Communities BBQ! It was a great time! Don't worry if you couldn't make it. There will be another chance next year—although it will look slightly different because of the upcoming election. I will speak more about that next month.

I do want to remind you that I send email notifications about events like my BBQ, Counciltalk, and other important information relating to municipal government. To receive them you must sign up at calgary.ca/ward14connect. I encourage you to do so.

#### Free Leaf and Pumpkin Drop-off

We are undeniably in autumn now, and the remains of summer are likely lying on your lawn waiting to be raked and bagged. My October column is the perfect opportunity to remind you of a great program we have at the City: the Leaf and Pumpkin Composting Program. It is currently underway, and runs until November 6. Bring your bagged leaves and pumpkins to one of our 35 drop-off locations around the city. By composting this material it stays out of the landfill, reduces harmful greenhouse gas emissions and helps turn the leaves and pumpkins into useful compost. We recommend using paper yard waste bags as they can be composted with the rest of the material. No sod or rocks please.

#### **Check your smoke detectors**

Now I want to make what you might call a public service announcement. Did you know that your smoke detector needs to be replaced every ten years? You should be replacing its batteries every year at least, and checking that it works every month.

October 9th to 15th is Fire Prevention Week. It may be the perfect opportunity to learn what you can do to protect your home and your family. There is a lot of great information about that and more at calgary.ca/fire.

#### Being prepared for snow

We didn't get much snow last winter, but if I have learned anything from this spring and summer, it is probably best to be prepared for anything. That is why I'm getting an early start on my usual snow clearing reminder this year.

Not much has changed. The City still aims to have all roads in drivable shape within seven days. Crews work on a priority basis. If necessary, the snow on your street will be packed down, and ruts will be removed anywhere between three and seven days after the end of the snowfall.

There are many ways to stay informed during a snowfall event. You can follow @yyctransport on twitter, download the City of Calgary Roads App, or visit calgary.ca/ roadconditions for current road conditions and progress. There is much more information about snow and ice control on calgary.ca/snow too.

One last thing: please pay attention to snow parking bans, and any other signage. Doing so will help everything get done as quickly and painlessly as possible.


