

Douglasdale/McKenzie Lake Slope Stability Project

November update

The City continues to move forward on priority remediation of the slope and pathway in a section behind Mt. Alberta View S.F.

The heavy rain this summer contributed to an increase in the slope movements on the escarpment east of the Bow River adjacent to the communities of Douglasdale and McKenzie Lake, damaging the City's pathway along a 3.5 km section.

Pathway closure remains in effect

The City closed the pathway for safety reasons in August and it remains closed. The pathway has been detoured along Mt. Alberta View and Mr. Douglas Close S.E. until remediation of the slope and the pathway can be completed.

What is happening now?

Geotechnical consultants have developed a detailed design for stabilizing the ground under the pathway and a contractor has been hired. Crews are on site and there is increased construction activity in the area.

The remediation work includes stabilizing the pathway and area at the top of the slope where the pathway has collapsed, which allows for the use of construction equipment in the area.

For safety reasons construction fencing has been set up to seal off the construction area. The City asks citizens to follow the detour signs and to not access either the closed area or the slope below it. This is for the safety of Calgarians and to maintain the stability of the slopes.

Monitoring of the pathway is ongoing and includes daily visual inspections of the 3.5 km section of the pathway including the closed area, and continued monitoring of the slope with inclinometers that are currently in place at the top of the slope.



Green Line LRT

2016 Year in Review

2016 has been a big year for the Green Line LRT project. We've had great conversations with thousands of Calgarians, continued to refine alignment options, and have even begun some preliminary infrastructure improvements in the southeast.

A few of the highlights from this year include:

- On October 4, 2016, City Council approved a fully tunneled LRT route in Calgary's downtown core.
- The Beltline alignment options have recently undergone an extensive evaluation. The results of the evaluation, which includes stakeholder and public input, indicate that 12 Avenue S is the preferred corridor. The Green Line project team will carry two options forward for further evaluation: 12 Avenue S Surface and 12 Avenue S Surface + Tunnel.
- The Green Line team met with and spoke to Calgarians along the corridor from north to south and everywhere in between. We've sought input from the public that informed the project team's recommendations to Council, and we conducted transit oriented development workshops in several communities on the north segment of the line.

What's Next

There are some major project milestones coming up in the first half of 2017, including the Beltline alignment recommendation to City Council (March 2017), and the final, full alignment recommendation to City Council (June 2017). As we explore and refine the details of the project, we will back in the community seeking input and sharing our progress.




