

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Another successful and busy hockey season has wound down for the Lake Bonavista Breakers, which is an appropriate time to recognize the literally hundreds of volunteers that make it and many other of our community recreational programs function and provide memorable fun experiences for our youth.





Think Twice About Gifting Rabbits for Easter

Rabbits are often given as gifts for Easter—and then quickly abandoned by families who underestimate what it takes to care for them.

Q. I have four pet rabbits and am always looking for ways to spread education about rabbit care, since it's not as simple as people realize. Could you talk about why it's a bad idea to give rabbits as an Easter gift to children? Education is key to making change for the better for all animals.

A. When given a choice between buying a live bunny or a plush rabbit toy for a young child at Easter, parents need to go with the plush toy (or chocolate bunny). Rabbits are not easy pets to care for and need adult caregivers to thrive. They require as much care as a dog or cat—and cost as much as a dog to care for over their lifetimes, according to the House Rabbit Society.

In addition, rabbits can become aggressive around sexual maturity, if not sterilized. And they can live eight to 14 years. Today's impulse gift for an 8-year-old child could still be in the family long after the child has finished college.

Rabbits are a "prey" animal, which means they will bolt in fear if they think their lives are in danger. Kids or animals in the home who are loud, lively and longing to chase them, can literally scare a rabbit to death.

While rabbits are the third most acquired pet, they are also the third most relinquished—and euthanized—pet. Sadly, people may dump their pet rabbits in the woods thinking they can survive, but that's a death sentence for them. Unlike wild rabbits, pet rabbits have no survival skills and can quickly succumb to starvation or become a food source for other animals if abandoned.

Very few animal shelters accept rabbits, so most homeless rabbits are cared for by rescue groups who try to find good homes for them, which brings me to my second point. Rabbits are actually great pets when placed in quiet homes with the right people. They are affectionate with their families and can be litter box trained, like a cat, so they can hop around the house.

If anyone reading this is serious about getting a rabbit, talk to rescue groups, like the Calgary Humane Society about rabbit care. They may even let you foster a rabbit to see if it's the right type of pet for you.

If you do your homework, are ready to make a decade-long commitment, and decide a rabbit is the best pet for your family, then you might be what these rabbit rescue groups are looking for in a rabbit parent.

Achieve Your Dreams: 6 Steps to Accomplish Your Goals and Resolutions

Don't let your goals and resolutions fall by the wayside. Chances are that to achieve your dreams and live a life you love, those goals and resolutions are crucial. Goal setting and goal achievement are easier if you follow these six steps for effective and successful goal setting and resolution accomplishment.

- 1. You need to deeply desire the goal or resolution. Napoleon Hill, in his landmark book, Think and Grow Rich, had it right. "The starting point of all achievement is desire. Weak desires bring weak results." So, your first step in goal setting and achieving your dreams is that you've got to really, really want to achieve the goal.
- 2. Visualize yourself achieving the goal. Lee lacocca said, "The greatest discovery of my generation is that human beings can alter their lives by altering their attitudes of mind." What will your achievement feel like? How will your life unfold differently as a result? If you can't picture yourself achieving the goal, chances are – you won't.
- 3. Make a plan for the path you need to follow to accomplish the goal. Create action steps to follow. Identify a critical path. The critical path defines the key accomplishments along the way, the most important steps that must happen for the goal to become a reality. Stephen Covey said, "All things are created twice. There's a mental or first creation, and a physical or second creation of all things. You have to make sure that the blueprint, the first creation, is really what you want, that you've thought everything through. Then you put it into bricks and mortar. You begin with the end in mind." He's right.
- 4. Commit to achieving the goal by writing down the goal. Lee lacocca said, "The discipline of writing something down is the first step toward making it happen." Write down the plan, the action steps and the critical path. In my own life, it is as if I am making a deeper commitment to goal accomplishment. I can't fool myself later. The written objective really was the goal.

- 5. Establish times for checking your progress in your calendar system, whatever it is: a day planner, a PDA, or a hand written list. If you're not making progress or feel stymied, don't let your optimism keep you from accomplishing your goals. No matter how positively you are thinking, you need to assess your lack of progress. Adopt a pessimist's viewpoint; something will and probably is, going to go wrong. Take a look at all of the factors that are keeping you from accomplishing your goal and develop a plan to overcome them. Add these plan steps to your calendar system as part of your goal achievement plan.
- 6. Review your overall progress regularly. Make sure you are making progress. If you are not making progress, hire a coach, tap into the support of loved ones, analyze why the goal is not being met. Don't allow the goal to just fade away. Figure out what you need to do to accomplish it. This six step goal setting and achieving system seems simple, but it is the most powerful system you will ever find for achieving your goals and living your resolutions. You just need to do it.




