

# Mid-Sun COMMUNITY **GARDEN NEWS**



I am so thankful that we are able to get out into the garden now with most thoughts of snow and frost behind us. Being in Calgary, we all know that April and May are a little dicey and that it's not

really until June comes around that we are able to garden to our hearts content! So get digging!

#### What's New in the Garden?

We did our garden registration in May and our little community garden is going through some awesome changes this season. Almost half of our gardens went to new neighbors this year. Like gardening itself, planting new ideas, trying new ways to improve our experiences and yielding greater results, all take significant amounts of time and energy to plan.

Last year, we created garden teams and descriptions for each of those teams, to familiarize gardeners with the responsibilities and expectations of people participating in communal gardening. It is not our intention to upset gardeners or alienate people who are already volunteering. It is our sole intention to have a pleasant and rewarding community gardening experience for everyone involved. One of my favorite sayings is "Many hands make light work," I love this because it exemplifies what community gardening is and should be.


- Payment is due at the time of registration.

#### RECYCLING

The Alberta Beverage Container Recycling Corporation provided us with a grant to purchase 15 dedicated beverage recycling bins for Midnapore Lake. We encourage all Park users to use these new bins to dispose of beverage containers that can be recycled rather than disposing of them in the garbage.

During the summer operating season, Park users will generate roughly 130 cubic yards of waste that is sent to the landfill.

The City of Calgary has made changes to the waste/ recycling bylaws that will affect how we collect and dispose of waste. The goal of the bylaw change is to reduce the amount of landfill waste material that could otherwise be diverted for compost or recycling.

Effective November 1, 2017 all food waste is to be separated from paper plates, napkins and plastics. Although this change does not affect our summer operation this year, in 2018 it will and we will introduce new recycling stations in the picnic areas in order that park users can separate food waste from paper or plastic products.

# Living in Harmony with Calgary Wildlife

One of my favorite things about Calgary is the animals in my yard. Calgarians encounter wildlife daily. I yield to deer weekly while driving. I've named the skunk living under our front porch "Fifi la Peuw". There's bats and owls in my backyard, and I cut walks short when coyotes are stalking my dogs in off leash areas. With spring comes the robins and the rest of the migratory birds, as well all the species that hibernate reappear. Then the babies appear.... Calgary is a city immersed in parklands and forests. Unfortunately, this often puts wildlife in conflict with the human inhabitants.

Good Samaritans are the bane of all baby animals. My staff and I spend hours on the phone arguing with wellintentioned determined people desperate to save the baby hare, fawn, or fledgling alone and uninjured. Does leave fawns for long periods of time, but are usually within hearing distance. Fawns and baby hares are naturally camouflaged and have no scent. Mother hares feed babies incredibly rich milk returning to feed them typically only at dusk and dawn. Baby hares run around within a day of birth. If you find a baby hare in a precarious position like on a road just tuck them somewhere safe nearby and walk away. Animals adapt behaviors to decrease the chance of predators finding their young. Respect this wisdom.

Many people incorrectly think a baby removed from the area cannot be returned. With a few species, a touch means rejection by the parents, but often if we can convince people to quickly put the baby back, parent animals will resume their duties.

Fledgling birds on the ground are in the precarious position between leaving the nest and flying. This doesn't occur instantaneously. The parent birds will follow the fledgling and feed it on the ground while it learns to fly. If flight school is in your backyard, keep children and pets away. If the baby is still a helpless nestling and fell out of the nest too early, return the bird to the nest. If the nest has fallen, secure an open container with drainage holes and the fallen nest inside back in the tree. Most baby birds, squirrels, and hares die of infection when people attempt to hand-raise them, not to mention missing out on life lessons from their parents. A wild animal's best chance of survival is with its parents, NOT you.

If you have concerns about wild creatures in your yard call the Alberta Institute for Wildlife Conservation Hotline at 403-946-2361. They are a charitable foundation with extensive facilities designed to accept all species of wildlife. They can also give you advice to deal with unwanted wildlife sharing your home, such as skunks, raccoons, bats, squirrels, and pigeons. Check out their website: www.aiwc.ca.

Many veterinary clinics will take in wildlife brought to us by the public. At my clinic, some animals are held briefly and released, especially the drunken waxwings eating fermented berries in the fall or birds simply stunned by flying into a window. A very few animals are immediately humanely euthanized because their injuries are too severe. Most animals are checked over and transferred to AIWC which has a fleet of volunteer drivers. An information sheet is filled out for every wild animal admitted, ideally to try to eventually release it to home territory, as well as for education and funding purposes. Volunteer if you really want to learn how to help our wild neighbors.

Knowing and adhering to the regulations in the Responsible Pet Ownership Bylaw 23M2006 helps to ensure that dogs are not being a nuisance in the community and dogs and citizens are safe.

City of Calgary would like to remind dog owners of the

- When off of their owner's property, dogs must be on a leash unless in a designated off-leash area.
- · When in designated off-leash areas, dog owners must ensure their dog is under control, is within their sight and responds to commands.
- Parking lots adjacent to off-leash areas are on leash.
- Owners are responsible for picking up all waste produced by their dog.
- Dogs are not allowed in school grounds, playgrounds, sport fields, golf courses, cemeteries, wading and swimming areas, and other areas prohibited by signs.
- Dogs must be walked on the right-hand side of the pathway on a leash that is no more than two metres in length and must not interfere with other pathway
- · Owners cannot cycle, in-line skate or skateboard on a pathway with a leashed dog.
- · Dogs must not enter or swim in any body of water within a park except a river that runs through, or is adjacent to, a City park.
- Dogs must have and wear a City of Calgary licence when the dog is three-months-old

#### In the Legislature

Bill 9, An Act to Modernize Enforcement of Provincial Offences, came into force on May 1. The legislation will eliminate the use of warrants to enforce tickets and overdue fines for minor, non-traffic-related offences. Instead, collection of overdue fines will be enforced by restricting motor vehicle registry (MVR) services and other civil measures. I am very pleased about this new bill because it will allow police officers and court staff to focus their time on more serious and violent offences. Keep in mind that eliminating warrants applies to only minor, non-criminal infractions. An example of this would be failing to pay a transit fare.

#### Did you know:

- It is estimated court staff spend nearly 9,000 hours every year processing warrants related to minor offences.
- The cost associated with incarcerating individuals for minor infractions alone is estimated at \$800,000 a year.
- Approximately \$73,000 of that goes directly towards feeding and clothing inmates.
- There are approximately 200,000 outstanding warrants in Alberta.
- About 45 per cent of the outstanding warrants are for minor provincial and municipal bylaw infractions.
- · Despite initiatives targeting warrants the number of outstanding warrants has continued to grow.

#### **Building Affordable Housing**

Since coming into office I have had the pleasure of meeting with many seniors in Calgary Shaw. Seniors contribute so much to our society and it is very important to me that they are able to have a high-quality standard of living in Alberta.

That is why are continuing our \$1.2 billion investment in affordable housing projects over five years which includes many seniors independent and lodge units across Alberta. This is four times what the previous government did. Further, we are taking action to address affordable housing issues by developing a Provincial Affordable Housing Strategy that will guide affordable housing development across the province both now and for the future.


Throughout the province, there are over 40 major capital development projects currently underway totaling \$530 million, 33 of which are geared to seniors' housing. These projects will renew and replace approximately 2000 units and add over 1000 units of new space.

Alberta Seniors and Housing is improving the condition of affordable housing facilities, including lodges and seniors self-contained units. Funding is being provided to ensure lodges are equipped with fire sprinklers to ensure the safety of residents.

That is all I have for June. Remember to dust off the boots and hats for July!


