# Summer is Fast Approaching...

Today, I am again writing on behalf of the Shepard Executive Board to bring you up to speed on community events.

Firstly, this newsletter. For the time being, we will continue to publish but on a reduced bi-monthly basis for the rest of this year. You can look for editions in June, August, October and December in case you want to plan ahead for any advertising, stories or classified ads. Thank you to the person that wrote in to suggest we publish an e-version. At this time, the complications include "dinosaur speed" internet service to a big number of our rural residences, no ability to mass email as that is reserved for active (paid-up) membership services. By posting it on the Shepard Hall website only, that would mean all interested readers would have to be computer-savvy, proactive and log in every month for updates which wouldn't likely happen.

Shepard's 2nd Annual Community Cleanup Drop-off and "Recycle Me" Store at the hall parking lot is on Sunday, June 18 from 9am – 1:30pm. Watch for signage around the community with last minute details of all the vendors that will be onsite so you can recycle your "whatever." Also, looking for volunteers that can help us tell folks where to go – to unload in the parking area of course! The list of vendors includes:

- **Household Garbage**
- **Compost** materials/tree branches, etc.
- **Blue Box** household recycling (cardboard, glass, etc.)
- **Metals** – all kinds of scrap metal (no freon items)
- **Electronics** – includes computers, printers, hard drives (he will destroy these), TV's, radios, cells & cords, old tools, smaller appliances – (anything that may have had an electrical source attached to it is accepted)
- **Bicycles** – all conditions (Kiwans Club will refurbish & recycle back to the community)
- **Tires, Rims & Batteries** (all batteries including household and vehicle)
- **Household Charity Items** including gently used & clean clothing, shoes, accessories, bed & bath, books, DVDs, CDs, kitchenware, etc. (for the Cerebral Palsy Association). Bins are available inside the hall lounge now if you want to start early PLUS there's a limited supply of CPA GREEN collection bags available to pick up at the hall office so you can start cupboard cleaning sooner.
- **Book Swap** – great opportunity to refresh your summer reading materials

- **RECYCLE ME Free Store** – kinda fun to see the swapping that goes on at this station!!
- **Old Mattresses** (call ahead to the hall if you need a mattress bag for transport)
- **Coffee, beverages, munchies**, chitter chatter and much more...!

Items that CAN'T be accepted at this event include fridges, freezers, air conditioners, household chemicals, paints, windows, railroad ties, propane tanks.

Note - If you are a senior and are challenged with bringing items to the site, please leave a message at the hall and we'll see where we can find a volunteer to assist.

In other news, the City is still following up on our several complaints offered at the last meeting of illegal dumping around the area. They did not have the action plan responses back yet at time of this writing. A reminder to report all issues by calling 311 or thru the City website link at <https://calgary-csrprod.cwi.motorolasolutions.com/Public/ServiceRequest.mvc/SRIIntake>.

Shepard Insider Tip > Word from our Federal MP's office (Tom Kmiec) at the last meeting that, as a part of the Canada 150 celebrations this year, there are Canadian flags available at no cost. They can be picked up directly at his Calgary office on Glenmore Trail at Ogden Road (Glenmore Inn Plaza) during office hours but I recommend you call ahead to ensure supplies are available as they are limited and will go fast once word gets around. If you need a refresher of your weary and weathered flag or would like to start showing how proud YOU are to be a Canadian, this is the perfect opportunity!

So, our next monthly meeting is Wednesday, June 21 at 7pm – the more, the merrier!

Here's to keeping YOU on track and hope to see many at the Cleanup Day even if you just want to drop by for a visit & coffee!

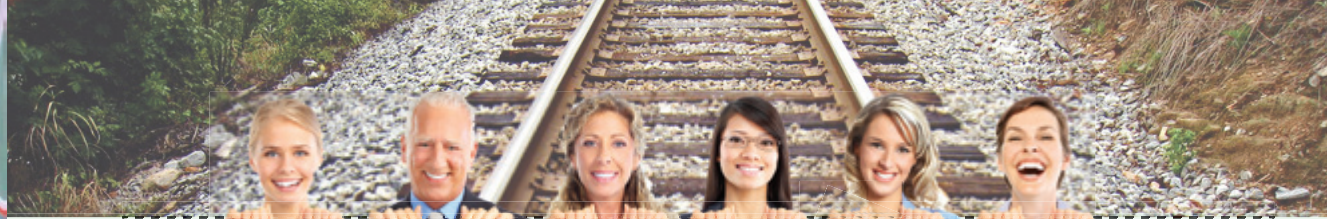
