## Tom Brook Athletic Park Redevelopment

The City is moving forward with plans to redevelop Tom Brook Athletic Park behind Southland Leisure Centre in the spring of 2018. Construction will take approximately one year and will upgrade the existing ball diamond and natural turf rectangular field with two rectangular artificial turf fields.

Tom Brook Athletic Park has been identified as a strategic location for artificial turf based on amenities at Southland Leisure Centre that make this an appealing multisport tournament venue for amateur athletes. The project will also add additional parking to the north side of Southland Leisure Centre.

### Impacts to Residents

We understand that construction creates additional dust and noise, and will do our best to minimize disruptions and ensure the safety of our neighbours. ### St. Gerard School



# 2017 Garden Report

## Preparing for the Garden Season

Are you planning on starting your plants from seed? Well now is the time to prepare what you are wanting to grow in your garden for the season that is not too far off.

After being in the community garden for the past 6 years this is the year I plan on growing my garden from seedlings that will be started in my living room. Early March is a good time to start seeding you plants. A good majority of plants will take up to two to three weeks before you see your seeds starting to germinate.

## Recommended and easy plants to grow in Calgary are as follows:

**Beans**- Varieties that grow well in Calgary - Stingless Green Pod (Bush Bean), Blue Lake Bean (Pole Bean)

**Beets**-Beets are incredibly healthy for you. Both the roots and the leaves are an excellent source of antioxidants, minerals, and vitamin C.

Sow seeds directly in the garden one month before the last frost date. Sow 1 inch deep, and 3 inches apart. Space rows 12 inches apart. Beet seeds are actually compound seeds; several individual beet seeds are contained in one seed. When the plants are about three inches tall, thin the beets to one per every 3 inches.

Varieties that grow well in Calgary - Detroit Dark Red, Burpee's Golden, Early Wonder

**Lettuce**-Lettuce is easy to grow and matures quickly. Do successive plantings every two weeks to space out your harvest. This allows you to have fresh lettuce throughout the growing season.

Sprinkle the seeds in rows on the soil surface. Leaf lettuce seeds are small, so sow thinly. Cover the seeds with ¼ inch of fine soil. Space rows 18 inches apart. Thin the

lettuce once the seedlings have sprouted leaving 6 to 8 inches between each plant.

Varieties that grow well in Calgary - Prize head (Leaf Lettuce), Cos or Romaine (Romaine Lettuce)

**Spinach**-Spinach is a cold weather plant and does well here in Calgary because of our cool spring weather. Spinach will bolt in warm weather so it is best planted as soon as the soil can be worked.

Sow spinach seeds 4 to 6 inches apart, ½ inch deep. Space rows 14 inches apart.

Varieties that grow well in Calgary - Bloomsdale Long-standing, Tyees

**Zucchini**-Zucchini is a great producer and grows very quickly.

Sow the seeds directly into the soil after the last frost date. Sow seeds 1 inch deep. Sow 3 seeds in each spot you want a plant to grow and thin to the strongest one. Space zucchinis 18 to 24 inches apart in rows 36 to 48 inches apart. Zucchini requires full sun and needs to be watered regularly once the plant is established.

Varieties that grow well in Calgary - Black Beauty, Elegance

**Peas**-Nothing beats the taste of peas that are freshly picked.

Peas prefer cool weather. Plant as early in spring as the soil can be worked. Use a seed inoculant and sow seeds 1 inch deep and 1-3 inches apart. Space rows 24 inches apart. Plant most varieties along a trellis or fence for support as they climb.

Varieties that grow well in Calgary - Sugar Snap, Little Green

**Radishes**-Radishes are one of the easiest, quickest growing crops you can plant in your garden.

Sow seeds ½ inch deep and 1 to 2 inches apart. If you plant at this spacing, you won't have to worry about thinning. Space rows 8 inches apart. Radishes need more water than most other root crops. If they don't get enough water, the roots turn woody and tough. Make sure that they get at least one inch of water per week.

Varieties that grow well in Calgary - Cherry Belle (round), French Breakfast (tubular)

**Carrots**-Carrots can be fussy to grow, but the taste of home grown carrots is worth the effort.

Sprinkle the seeds in rows on the soil surface. Carrot seeds are small, so sow thinly. Cover the seeds with ¼

inch of fine soil. Space rows 12 inches apart. It is very important to thin carrots in order to allow them room to grow. Thin young plants when they are 1 inch high leaving 1-2 inches between plants. As they grow, carrots push up, out of the soil, so hill soil up to prevent getting a green shoulder.

Varieties that grow well in Calgary - Scarlet Nantes, Red Cored Danvers

**Alyssum** is one plant that benefits the growth of carrots and radishes: over the last year I have come to realize that alyssum deter slugs and carrot rust flies, Aphids do not like this flower and will stay away from your Zucchini, as well as having a beautiful aroma.



Dear Constituents:

As we enter the second month of the New Year, I am happy to mention that I am chairing the Caucus Budget Advisory Committee: it works closely with the Minister of Finance and provides assistance to the ministry to prepare the upcoming spring budget 2017. I am glad to have this leadership opportunity to provide my insight into the budget to serve Albertans' best interests.

We are working hard towards job creation in our province: with new initiatives like the Energy Efficiency Program, the Alberta Investor Tax Credit and the Capital Investment Tax Credit, the Petrochemicals Diversification Program and with capital investment in roads, hospitals and schools, you will begin to see the effects in our economy. Since August of 2016 the province has added 25,000 jobs.

• Two new facilities approved under the **Petrochemical Diversification Program.**

- These plants, for the first time in Alberta, will process propane extracted from natural gas resources into value-added plastic products that people all over the world use every day. Both plants will operate in the Edmonton area (Sturgeon County and Strathcona County).
- During construction of the Pembina/PIC petrochemical processing facility, there would be an average of 2,000 to 2,500 workers on site, with more than 150 full-time operations and head office jobs upon completion. Construction is expected to start in 2019, with the facility operating by 2021.
- The second project, by Inter Pipeline, will create 2,000 full-time equivalent jobs over the three year construction period. About 1,600 of those would be at the site and the rest would be in fabrication or module shops and engineering firms. An additional 95 full-time operations positions would be created upon project start-up. Construction is expected to start in 2017, with the facility operating in 2021.

• New wells drilled under **Modernized Royalty Framework**

- Since July, 129 new wells have been drilled in Alberta under the modernized royalty framework.
- Each new well supports 135 direct and indirect jobs and about \$4.5 million in spending.
- It was clear that the old method of confrontational politics of shouting at Ottawa and the other provinces, was not working to get Alberta better access to markets for our oil and gas products.
- We chose a different path and decided to build a plan that would protect our environment and build our energy economy. The pipeline approvals are proof that this plan worked: When Prime Minister Trudeau announced these pipeline approvals, he said, "Let me say this definitively, we could not have approved this project without the leadership of Premier Notley and Alberta's climate leadership plan."
- Starting in early 2017, **Energy Efficiency Alberta** will deliver a variety of programs and services for energy efficiency and small scale renewables.
  - Free installation of residential efficiency products such as lighting, water fixtures, and heating components in homes across Alberta.
  - Rebates for efficient appliances, lighting, and insulation for homes.
  - Incentives for high-efficiency retrofits of lighting, heating, cooling, and hot water systems for businesses, non-profits, and institutions.

On January 5th of this year, the Assessment Department mailed out the 2017 Property Assessment Notices to property and business owners in Calgary. The assessment process is how property taxes are distributed among all property owners to meet The City's budget needs to pay for services all Calgarians benefit from like police, fire protection, transit, parks, recreation and more. Your property assessment provides the basis for your share of taxes, relative to all non-residential properties in Calgary. On June 27th, 2016, City Council made the decision to reduce the 2017 property tax rate increase to zero through a one-time rebate. Please note this only affects The City's portion. Your property assessment is based on your property's estimated market value on July 1st, 2016, and is used to calculate your property taxes. Your property assessment can change year to year.

### Residential Property Assessment

The average home in Calgary saw an assessment decrease of 4 per cent. If your assessment decreased 4 per cent, you will pay about the same municipal taxes as last year. If your assessment decreased less than 4 per cent or increased from 2016, your municipal taxes will increase. If your assessment decreased by more than 4 per cent, you will see a decrease in your municipal taxes. Please note, the Provincial portion of the tax rate is not announced until spring, and will also have an impact on your property taxes.

### Non-residential Property Assessment

The average non-residential property saw an assessment decrease of 6 per cent. If your assessment decreased 6 per cent, you will pay about the same municipal taxes as last year. If your assessment decreased less than 6 per cent or increased from 2016, your municipal taxes will increase. If your assessment decreased by more than 6 per cent, you will see a decrease in your municipal taxes. Please note that regulated assessments are not subject

to the market value standard, and assessment changes may not be reflective of the average 2017 assessment changes for non-residential properties. The Provincial portion of the tax rate will impact your property taxes. This is not announced until spring. The Business Tax Consolidation will also impact your property taxes.

### Business Tax Consolidation

The City is phasing out the Business Tax through a gradual transfer of the business tax revenues to the non-residential property tax. Each year, business tax bills will go down and non-residential property tax bills will increase. The Business Tax will be eliminated in 2019. Consolidating the taxes into a single, easy to understand real estate-based assessment and tax system for non-residential property owners will make Calgary more competitive and attractive for business. Please note that Business Tax Consolidation will not impact your property/business assessment nor will it be reflected on your assessment notice. It will not increase the amount of revenues collected by The City.

### Customer Review Period

The Customer Review Period is from January 5th to March 6th, 2017. If you have any questions about your assessment, please contact 403-268-2888. Changes can only be made to your 2017 Property Assessment during the Customer Review Period.

The City offers online tools to help property owners understand and review their assessment. By logging into Assessment Search at [calgary.ca/assessment](http://calgary.ca/assessment), you can access details on your property to check and review the accuracy of the information The City has on file, and compare your assessment with other similar properties in your area to ensure your assessment is fair and equitable. You may also conduct more in-depth assessment research and can access sales, community and property reports.
