The spring sitting of the Legislature began March 2nd with the Speech from the Throne. In it, the government outlined their agenda, including cuts to school fees, capping electricity rates and formalizing the phase-out of coal-fired power by 2030.

While I agree with some of their ideas, in particular relief for families paying some of the highest school fees in the country, there doesn't seem to be a plan to pay for these promises; or at least no plan beyond unsustainable levels of debt.

I acknowledge there are no easy answers to the economic challenges facing our province. As the economic downturn moves into its third year, many people are wondering what the future holds for our province. Will the government ever balance the budget, let alone start to pay back our debts? Will a new government slash public spending, lay off hundreds if not thousands of public servants and decimate front-line public services? Or is there another path?

Earlier this spring I released a white paper called Pathway to Prosperity, which you can find on the Alberta Party Caucus website at www.abpartycaucus.ca. I believe it's time to consider all options, and to ensure we ask Albertans what they think along the way, which is why I'm asking for your feedback. Please contact my office at the information below to share your thoughts on this document or anything else you'd like to tell me.

In terms of specifics, I believe the solution should include finding savings in government spending without hurting front-line services. It means ending our reliance on unpredictable resource revenues once and for all, while ensuring our energy industry remains strong. It means making our tax system as efficient as it can be and creating an attractive investment climate. I believe Albertans should keep more of their hard-earned money and we should examine new, stable sources of revenue to provide sustainable funding for core public services.

Alberta can once again become a vibrant province that attracts people from all over the country and around

the world. We can have a robust economy, efficient government, clean environment, innovative education and healthcare systems, a great guality of life, and a community that values diversity. We can continue to have a world-leading energy industry while also taking a step into the next economy.

All of this is possible if we're willing to think differently. It's time for Albertans to do what we've always done; ask difficult questions and not be afraid of the answers.

Last October, Alberta Conservative Members of Parliament launched the Alberta Jobs Taskforce to deal with the jobs crisis in the province. Alberta's unemployment rate rose from 4.6 % to 8.8 % in the last 18 months with Calgary having one of the highest rates in Canada at over 10 %. The result has been a spike in the incidence of crime and its severity as well as family violence.

The objectives of the Task Force were two fold. First, listen to Albertans, employers, workers, families and other stakeholders affected by the job crisis and collect their feedback and ideas. Second, to collate that information into a report containing recommendations and in a few instances budget requests of the Liberal Government.

The Calgary Signal Hill riding partnered with Calgary Confederation and Calgary Centre hosting a round table discussion followed by an open meeting where constituents brought forward their ideas and suggestions. Calgary Signal Hill constituents also were given the opportunity to participate by an email survey and close to 2,000 responded.

Here are some of the task force's recommendations: • Elimination of the federal carbon tax

- Reduction of the small business tax rate
- Reversing the mandatory increase on CPP premiums
- Respecting the non-partisan decisions of the National Energy Board with respect to the construction of new pipelines
- Investments in programs and opportunities to enhance youth employment in Alberta
- Reviewing the equalization payment formula
- Advocating for Canadian resources and Canadian industry abroad

• Provide a clear plan to bring the federal budget back into balance.

As the seasons change, now is an opportunity to remind ourselves of the amazing spaces we have in our communities. Here are some of my favourite parks in the Ward 6 area that you can visit:

Griffith Woods Park

The Elbow River flows unimpeded through this beautiful park in Discovery Ridge. Seldom can one experience a "wild river" within a major city. The curves in this part of the river has left "oxbow" wetlands, with a rich variety of aquatic ecosystems, along with one of only two large strands of White Spruce in The City's park system.

Strathcona Ravine

Tucked away between the Strathcona and Christie Park communities, these 23 hectares of ravines were set aside as an environmental reserve during the 1970s. The boardwalk at the west end crosses a seasonal stream and wetland, and is an excellent area for birdwatching. If you want to experience a classic ravine in the wilds of Calgary, this natural gem is the park to visit.

Battalion Park

Originally a World War 1 training camp known as Camp Sarcee in 1915, this Signal Hill park was built to commemorate the Alberta soldiers who trained here. 16,000 stones were placed here by members of the Calgary, Lethbridge, Central Alberta, and Edmonton battalions, and were formed into their regiment numbers: 137, 113, 151, and 51. Along with its historical significance, the park includes great views, pathways, and of course, shopping opportunities in Westhills afterwards. *For more information, visit Calgary.ca/parks*

Want to send your kids on an action-packed nature adventure this summer? Calgary Parks is offering Nature Day Camps in July and August, connecting children with the natural world through hands-on activities and outdoor play. Guided by experienced educators, campers will explore bugs, birds, plants and animals while gaining a better understanding of nature and their place within it. 


