Season's Greeting from Silvera for Seniors

Silvera for Seniors wishes everyone a happy and safe holiday season. We appreciate your dedication to the community and value everyone's contribution to the vision for the new Silvera at Glamorgan development.

It has been an exciting year for Silvera. In 2017, Horizon Housing started constructing its new town houses and apartment building on the land it purchased from Silvera. Also, this year we finalized our vision to develop new buildings that will provide supportive living and memory care suites, self-contained senior apartments and multi-generational housing. Seniors' housing will be on the west portion, connected to Westview, and multi-generational housing is proposed for the eastern portion, adjacent to the Horizon Housing buildings.

In September Silvera applied for a land use amendment for a Direct Control (DC) District for the remaining lands. This land use change was suggested by the City of Calgary as a means of implementing the vision. The land use application specifies different building heights for portions of the site, with lower form development adjacent to the existing homes on Glamorgan

Crescent SW and higher buildings adjacent to Glenmore Trail SW.

The new DC also permits community access to existing commercial and retail uses that generally would only serve Silvera residents. The services available to residents and neighbours may include wellness and recreation facilities, a small retail/tuck shop, a coffee shop/bistro, a hair salon and medical services. Traditionally these services were only available to our live-in residents and this change will welcome family members and community neighbours as customers. It does not permit free-standing commercial uses but only permits access to the services previously only available to residents.

The land use application will go to the Calgary Planning Commission and City Council early in 2018. For more information on the application, please go to www.silveraglamorgan.com.

As 2017 closes, we can look back on the past year and be thankful for many things: oil prices appear to be holding above \$50 (at the time of writing this article); optimism that oil may hit \$60 per barrel over the next few months; and improved optimism in many other sectors of our economy, including technology, agriculture, and service.

2017 was also a time to CELEBRATE Canada's 150th birthday, with many celebrations taking place across the country, province, and locally with community events in our riding of Calgary Signal Hill. We anticipate the memorable celebration to conclude this momentous year.

Even as we remain thankful for many things, it's an unfortunate truth that there are real causes for concern over the year ahead. There is a concern resulting from eco-activism in areas, such as pipeline approvals and construction. Both federal and provincial governments seem to be moving ahead with initiatives that will sterilize large tracts of energy development lands in Northern Alberta, and designate those regions as protected caribou habitat—a serious blow to an energy sector that is already struggling.

This past year also saw the government introduce their second federal budget with a deficit of nearly \$20 billion. After last year's \$17 billion deficit, they will need to make plans to balance the budget in a timely fashion difficult to minimize the impacts on all Canadians especially in Alberta where many are still struggling as a result of the economic downturn.

The summer of 2017 saw the government attempt to introduce a series of new taxes on small business. Those who met with much resistance by several stakeholders such as farmers, medical offices and accountants, the government listened and eventually were forced to back off on most of their proposals.

In 2018, we can also expect the legalizing of marijuana just in time for Canada Day putting the province in the position of developing the guidelines for distribution, monitoring and policing. As well there is ongoing negotiations that could completely re-structured the current trade deal with the United States and NAFTA.

One can hope that we see real progress on the Trans Mountain and Keystone pipelines in 2018, so that Alberta producers can get their product to market.

Please let me express sincere gratitude for your feedback this past year. I look forward to continuing my work as your representative in Ottawa in 2018. From my family to yours, I would like to wish you, your family, and friends a safe and joyous Christmas and the best for the holiday season.

Holiday Pet Safety

The holiday season is a joyful time for many who want to include their pets in the festivities by sharing treats from the dinner table and having them be a part of the celebrations. Here are some tips and considerations to keep your pet safe:

Food:

- Leftover food that is rich, spicy, or fatty can be hard for pets to digest.
- Many foods are toxic or harmful for pets, including: turkey bones, artificial sweeteners and other baking ingredients, chocolate, and alcohol.
- Secure the lid on your garbage can or put your garbage outside right after the meal.

Décor:

- Poinsettias, Christmas cactus, and holly are toxic to cats and dogs.
- Secure your Christmas tree if you have pets that like to climb.
- Hang breakable ornaments higher on your tree.
- With natural trees, make sure pets don't drink the water.
- Shiny tinsel and ribbons are appealing for cats, but if swallowed can cause serious injury or lead to surgery.
- Unplug holiday lights and extension cords prior to leaving your home.
- Don't put candy or chocolates under the tree.

Socializing:

- While hosting parties, give your pet a safe and quiet place to retreat.
- Be mindful as guests come and go as it's easy for pets to slip out unnoticed.

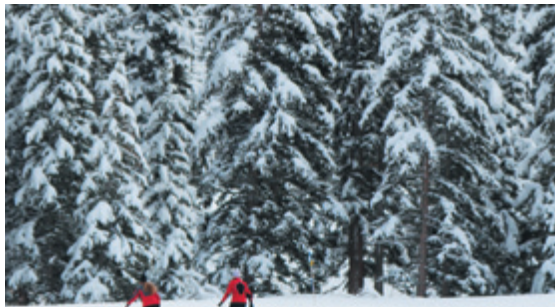
Networking 101

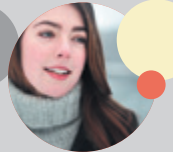
