

Membership **Drive for 1,000**

Get onboard! Haysboro Community Association wants to see 1,000 paid memberships by the end of May. And with the small annual Membership fee dropping to \$5 for both individuals and families, most everyone can opt in.

Haysboro Community Association has 457 paid memberships. But there's lots of room for growth with 3,000 residential homes in the community. The Association wants to include those who find Membership fees a hardship.

"Fees shouldn't be a financial barrier; memberships strengthen our association and our community," said Kourtney Branagan, President of the HCA. "The board is all volunteer run, as is Pub Night, Easter Egg Hunt, Jane's Walk, Scavenger Hunt, Community Clean Up, the Casino fundraiser and Garden Coalition to name a few," she explained. "The Senior's Resource Group has various excursions, barbeques and Christmas socials to look after. And even the rink and tennis/pickle ball court need maintenance."

Members get cut-rate tickets to events, access to the tennis/pickle ball court and exceptional facility rental discounts. They also have voting privileges at the annual general meeting.

Haysboro Preschool Gets A-Plus

It was another rocking year of growth for preschool classes in Haysboro. Young families are repopulating the otherwise well-known seniors' community of Haysboro, and teacher Kerry Urban, who has her master's in education, says the classrooms are near capacity.

"Last school year, enrollment was 40," Urban explained. "This year we are at 44. Classes are capped at 12 each, so with four classes, we are almost full."

Three-year-olds have classes Tuesday and Thursday mornings or afternoons. Four-year-olds attend Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings, or Monday and Wednesday afternoons. Each class is 2.25 hours. New to 2019/20, there will be a three-and four-year-old split class.

"By attrition, the three-year-olds are moving up and we find we have more room in those classes. With that, we have more fouryear-olds and we don't want to turn anyone away," said Urban. "We've done multi-age classes in the past. It's educationally sound and a reality in cities everywhere."

Teachers Urban and Allison Rau-Dobson are both Alberta certified instructors. Not only do children in Haysboro have the benefit of professional teachers, but the curriculum is solidly built for individual learning. Mighty Learners is a program endorsed by Alberta's Early Childhood Services which uses the Early Learning Curriculum Framework. This instructs young children to nurture their learning through play. Play is defined as the best learning tool. "Our curriculum is play-based," said Urban. "The children's pre-academic learning goals can be experienced through structured play."

Another program incorporated into the classroom and designed in conjunction with Alberta Education is Big Plans for Little Kids. It's a partnership with preschools for early intervention. This program screens children for speech impediments, motor skills, coping strategies and behavioural patterns. It's another benefit provided by Haysboro preschool. "They strengthen our program and their model is wonderful. We're glad to have this to offer," said Urban. "These are young citizens of the community. Here they build networks that will take them into high school and beyond."


