Conditions permitting, the Glenmore Reservoir is expected to open for recreational use on May 1st, 2019. Rentals available include kayaks, canoes, and sailboats. Rack, mooring, and stall rentals, registered sailing lessons with our Glenmore Sailing School, and even racing opportunities for more advanced sailors are also available. For Reservoir status, rentals, and program registration information visit calgary.ca/sailing.
