

Preparing for the SW Ring Road Construction & **Anderson Road Widening Project**

With The City looking to increase the thoroughfare on Anderson Road to six lanes between the Southwest Ring Road (SWRR) and Elbow Drive, construction is once again a traffic concern in our Ward. This road improvement, while cumbersome, looks to provide a better road network by offering an attractive alternative for people travelling east-west through the area between the SWRR and city destinations. Construction on this project is expected to begin June 2017 and will be wrapped up by the end of 2018.

Another issue that has been brought to my attention is the approximate 111 trees that were removed along Anderson Road between Elbow Drive and the future SWRR last month. I find this to be very disappointing, however by the time the project wraps up at the end of 2018, The City will have replanted 281 poplar and **spruce trees** along this stretch of Anderson Road.

Surrounding Area Construction Updates

162nd Avenue SW Connections: Construction on the 162nd Avenue SW connection project will be starting July 2017 and is expected to be completed in fall 2017. The roadway will not open to traffic until the SWRR is completed – fall 2021.

Some Ward 13 residents may notice periodic increases in construction traffic throughout the project. They will be limiting access from eastbound 162nd Avenue to Bridlecrest Blvd SW but will remain open until the SWRR is completed. Once the SWRR is open, the left turn from 162nd Avenue to Bridlecrest Boulevard will be **perma**nently closed.

Glenmore Trail Widening and Interchange Upgrade:

The City will be widening Glenmore Trail to six lanes between 37 Street and Crowchild Trail SW and modifying the Glenmore Trail / Crowchild Trail SW interchange. These upgrades will help to provide a better road network by accommodating changes to traffic volume and patterns that are expected after the opening of the SWRR. The design work for the Glenmore Trail widening and interchange upgrades are scheduled to begin in late 2017, with construction planned to start in 2018 and continue into 2019.



Aside from being a popular spice, ginger truly is a superfood. Its health benefits range from being a natural antibiotic, to its anti-inflammatory properties, to its digestive soothing effects, and more. One of my favorite ways to enjoy ginger is in tea form and it's so easy to make at home.

I make my ginger tea using raw, pealed, ginger root and filtered water. The amount of ginger I use varies depending on who will be drinking it. I love the taste of ginger, so I'll use quite a lot when I make it for myself. This also means that my tea packs a pretty big nutritional punch because I use so much of the root.

Simply put the raw, pealed ginger root in a pot with the filtered water and bring it to a boil. In the Legislature

As the Spring session of the Legislature continues, I have been working hard to make sure your voice is represented in Edmonton. In my last newsletter I asked for constituent's stories about school fees. Many constituents sent me stories about how school fees have impacted their pocketbook. I am proud to say that I am a co-sponsor of Bill 1: An Act to Reduce School Fees. Through finding efficiencies in other areas of Education we will be able to cover this cost. This will eliminate school fees for instructional supplies and materials for the 2017/2018 school year. It will also eliminate fees for busing students to their designated school. This will save Alberta families more than \$50 million a year.

Budget 2017

On March 16, we announced our 2017 budget. It makes life more affordable for everyday Albertans by capping electricity prices, reducing school fees and keeping taxes on families the lowest in Canada.

We're helping young people find more opportunities by capping post-secondary tuition fees and funding more apprenticeships and training. Furthermore, we are putting more money back into the pockets of Alberta families with carbon levy rebates and the Alberta Child Benefit and Employment Tax Credit. At the same time investment in long-overdue repairs and modernizations of our schools and hospitals and critical improvements to our roads and highways will keep Albertans working and make life better for people who need those services. This budget will fund 24 new and modernized schools across Alberta, a new hospital in Edmonton and a new long-term care home in Calgary.

Now is not the time to make drastic cuts to services that Albertans need. I believe the government should be providing a steady hand and a clear vision that puts everyday Albertans and families first.



Provincial Budget Announcement

We received the provincial budget on March 16 and are pleased that the Province continues to prioritize public edu-

We are the largest school board in the province, representing about one-sixth of all Alberta students. Next year alone, we will welcome over 2,000 new students into our classrooms, bringing our enrolment to over 121,000 students. Each of our students deserves the high quality education that Calgary families have come to expect.

This government has stated it wants to protect and improve public education. Providing funding for each and every child is the responsibility of the provincial government. Even with funding for enrolment growth, we will still have a gap between the amount we receive, and the amount necessary to maintain current educational service levels for our students. Therefore, we are worried that government funding may not be able to protect and improve public education.

We are committed to working with the provincial government and our staff and parents to continue to make decisions based on our values; students come first, learning is our central purpose and public education serves the common good.

We support the government's intention to make life more affordable for all families with the introduction of Bill 1: An Act to Reduce School Fees. We also have some concerns about this. Our initial analysis indicates that about one in four students who currently ride a yellow school bus will benefit from Bill 1. The rest could see fees increased and services reduced or eliminated.

With Bill 1, the government has taken over responsibility for setting service levels and the related fees. We are worried that we will be required to make decisions contrary to what we heard from parents last year during our transportation engagement.

We look forward to working with the government to ensure we protect and improve public education for each and every student.




