Proposed By-law Amendment on membership

The SWCA Board has determined that the business of the Community association can be done more effectively if we make two changes. One is to fix the membership validity to the membership year, rather than having a myriad of start and end dates for membership, which is very time consuming to track. The other is to change the Membership Year to correspond to our Fiscal Year. This requires the following two amendments to the ByLaws of the Association and this can be done at a General Meeting of the Association. This notice is for that General Meeting.

Amendment 1:

Section 2.2, currently stating:

"...All memberships described above with the exception of honorary memberships and volunteer memberships shall be valid for exactly one year from the date it was purchased by payment of the required fee of the ensuing year and verified by the Association..."

Is amended to state:

"...All memberships described above with the exception of honorary memberships and volunteer memberships shall be valid for exactly one Membership Year and may be purchased by payment of the required fee of that year and be verified by the Association..."

Amendment 2:

Section 6.3, currently stating

"...The membership year of the Association shall commence on the first day of July each year, and shall continue until the last day in June each year..."

Is amended to state:

"...The membership year of the Association shall commence on the first day of March each year, and shall continue until the last day in February each year..."

Please plan on coming to the General meeting to vote on these amendments and meet the Board and other community members.
